

ORDINANCE #2119-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY SECTION 55-8 REGARDING PERMITTED HOURS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UNDER A PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that the Code of the City of Woodbury Section 55-8 B (1) is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

“(1) For holders of a plenary retail consumption license, alcoholic beverages may be sold, served or delivered on a licensed premises between the hours of 11 a.m. and 12 p.m., except that when New Years Day falls on a Monday, such sales may continue to 2:00 a.m. the next succeeding day.”

All remaining sections of the afore-described ordinance not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on May 10, 2010. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on May 24, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk’s Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
