

ORDINANCE # 2122-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #2121-10, "TO FIX AND ESTABLISH SALARIES AND RATE OF COMPENSATION ON THE VARIOUS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, AND TO PROVIDE THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH"

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Woodbury adopted Ordinance #2121-10 on June 28, 2010, and it is necessary to amend said ordinance with changes to the following sections:

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of the ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
