

**ORDINANCE #2127-10**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER A237 SECTION 52 C OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Woodbury that Chapter A237 Section 52, Subsection C of the Code of the City of Woodbury is hereby amended and shall henceforth read in its entirety as follows:

- “C. Employees who have retired after 25 years of full-time service to the City of Woodbury or who have retired and reached the age of 62 years or older with at least 18 years of full-time service with the City of Woodbury may continue to receive paid health insurance coverage. Employees receiving retiree health benefits must notify the Deputy Clerk in writing, with proof of enrollment, when they become eligible for Medicare Parts A and B. For more information, consult the Deputy Clerk. Coverage becomes effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month following the successful completion of the first sixty (60) days of employment. Enrollment cards are available from the Deputy Clerk. It is the employee’s responsibility to notify the Clerk of any change in dependent status by completing updated enrollment cards.”

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that:

- I. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
- II. This Ordinance shall take effect after the second reading and publication as required by law.

**THE FOREGOING** was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on December 13, 2010. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on December 27, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
