RESOLUTIONS

RESOLUTION #05-134 - RESOLUTION TO AWARD THE PARK AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Councilwoman Tierney presented the above-entitled resolution.

The Deputy Administrator read the title of the resolution.

Councilwoman Tierney inquired from the Engineer what portion of the project the City was paying for and what Deptford Township was contributing to the costs.

Joe Schiavo explained that there was \$300,000 in grants involved, and the remaining portion was split between Deptford & Woodbury for the roads portion, but Woodbury bears the cost for water/sewer.

On motion of Councilwoman Tierney, seconded by Councilwoman Schreyer, the resolution was adopted by a voice vote.

RESOLUTION #05-135 - RESOLUTION TO AWARD THE WICK BOULEVARD STORMWATER AND WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Councilwoman Tierney presented the above-entitled resolution.

The Deputy Administrator read the title of the resolution.

Councilman Grimming inquired if this project would correct the flooding problems many of the residents have been experiencing in their backyard.

Mr. Schiavo stated it would greatly improve the situation; but not totally correct the problem.

On motion of Councilwoman Tierney, seconded by Councilwoman Schreyer, the resolution was adopted by a voice vote.

RESOLUTION #05-136 - RESOLUTION TO AWARD INSTALLATION OF FLASHING WARNING DEVICES AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS PROJECT

Councilwoman Tierney presented the above-entitled resolution.

The Deputy Administrator read the title of the resolution.

On motion of Councilwoman Tierney, seconded by Councilwoman Schreyer, the resolution was adopted by a voice vote.

PUBLIC

Anthony Chiesa, 36 Rugby Place approached Council to ask if the Rugby Place draining problem has been addressed. President Riskie stated that when Mr. Chiesa came before Council the Public Works Department was advised to look into the request. President Riskie stated that someone from the Public Works Department will be touch with Mr. Chiesa to advise him of their findings.

Mr. Chiesa also inquired if the current tax bills reflect the fact that the City of Woodbury received the Extraordinary Aid relief from the State.

President Riskie advised that the Extraordinary Aid was included in the current tax bills the residents received.

As no one else desired to address Council, on motion of Councilman Curtis, seconded by Councilman Graziani, the Public Portion was closed and the Regular Order of Business was resumed.
