

ORDINANCE #2175-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY REPEALING ORDINANCE #2170-12 AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR THE CONNECTIONS WITH SANITARY SEWER, AS TO SANITARY GREASE TRAPS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury passed Ordinance #2170-12 amending the Code of the Board of Health of the City of Woodbury requiring the installation of grease traps in certain establishments; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury wish to review and revise such regulations and implement regulations to address enforcement issues and table regulations to achieve the intended purpose without overburdening affected establishments.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that Ordinance #2170-12 is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on January 22, 2013. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on February 12, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
