ORDINANCE #2216-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY AMENDING CHAPTER 190-38 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY ESTABLISHING A THREE-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF FRANKLIN AND HOPKINS STREETS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodbury wishes to amend Chapter 190, Section 38, Schedule VIII of the Code of the City of Woodbury to include a three-way stop intersection as designated below; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended this modification; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury that:

1. Chapter 190, Section 38, Schedule VIII: Stop Intersections is hereby amended to include a three-way stop at the intersection of:

Franklin and Hopkins Streets

- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
- 3. Any Ordinance inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

THE FOREGOING was introduced by the City Council of the City of Woodbury at a regular meeting held on September 23, 2014. This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at final reading and public hearing to be held on October 14, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. or at such time as may be determined and announced, in City Hall, Council Chambers, 33 Delaware Street, Woodbury, New Jersey, at which time and place all persons interested will be given the opportunity to be heard concerning said Ordinance. During the time prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the City Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who may request same.
