

RESOLUTION #14-04

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A TEMPORARY BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 2014

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the governing body of the City of Woodbury, in order to properly conduct the affairs of the City from the present time until the final adoption of the 2014 budget, to make certain contracts and commitments and to authorize the payment of certain obligations and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 40A:4-19 of the Revised Statutes provide for temporary appropriations not in excess of 26.25% of the total appropriations made for all purposes in the budget for the preceding fiscal year excluding, in both instances, appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement fund and public assistance.

WHEREAS, the temporary appropriations hereinafter made and established are entirely within all limitations imposed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury as follows:

1. That the sum of **Three Million Seven Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,758,000.00)** is hereby appropriated to meet and pay the contracts, obligations, commitments and operating expenditures for the Current Fund hereinafter enumerated.

2. The appropriations made hereunder shall be allotted for the following governmental operations in the following sums:

There is hereby appropriated pursuant to the condition of said local budget law relating to temporary budgets, the sum of **One Million Four Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,466,400.00)** to meet and pay the operating expenditures of the Water and Sewer Consolidated Utility of the City of Woodbury as follows:
