**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE CITY OF WOODBURY'S PARTICIPATION
IN THE DELAWARE VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION'S
TRANSPORTATION & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE (TCDI)
GRANT PROGRAM**

RESOLUTION OF: The City of Woodbury in the County of Gloucester

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ supports the request for planning grant dollars from the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission not to exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ understands the grant amount requested must provide 20% of the total project cost as match in local, county, state, or private funds or documented in-kind services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ fully understands the application requirements and contracting process if awarded the planning grant dollars; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that , the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ **HEREBY AUTHORIZES** Randi Woerner, Director of Economic Development to the City of Woodbury to submit an application to DVRPC for a TCDI planning grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, the City of Woodbury, Gloucester County, NJ agrees to, if selected for the TCDI grant, to:

1. Engage in contracting procedures including the Request for Proposals and budget allocation;
2. Sign grant agreement documents;
3. Agree to submit reimbursement invoices and progress reports along with necessary supporting documentation on a quarterly basis;
4. Take all necessary action to complete the project associated with the grant agreement within the 24 month timeframe, and submit the final deliverable to DVRPC; and provide proof of adoption or acceptance by the governing body through a resolution that must be submitted no later than June 30, 2017 to DVRPC. DVRPC will reserve payment of the last 10% of the grant award until such resolution and the final deliverable is received.
