

RESOLUTION NO. 14-164

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FY2015 MUNICIPAL AID PROJECT HEREINAFTER KNOWN AS THE WEST BARBER AVENUE MILLING & OVERLAY

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury is in need of resurfacing the roadway, including milling and overlay, removal of curb barriers at intersections, installation of bicycle-safe inlet grates, and replacing damaged or missing concrete curbing along West Barber Avenue from South Broad Street to South Jackson Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has estimated the construction cost of the necessary improvements at approximately \$170,165 plus \$21,270 for design services plus \$14,180 for construction management & inspection services, for a total amount of \$205,605; and

WHEREAS, The City of Woodbury desires to prepare plans and specifications and to issue bid documents for construction in 2015, as funds become available.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Council of the City of Woodbury understands that the West Barber Avenue Milling and Overlay Project will be constructed in 2015, and the City of Woodbury formally approves the grant application for the above stated project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, CFO and City Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as Application ID No. MA-2015-Woodbury City 00476 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Woodbury; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, City Administrator, CFO and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Woodbury and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
