

**RESOLUTION #15-141**

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REQUIRING APPROVAL OF THE DIRECTOR OF  
THE DIVISION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES – N.J.S.A. 40A:4-49**

**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen with respect to the June 23, 2015 Straight Line Wind Storm and, no adequate provision was made in the 2015 budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation on an emergency appropriation for the purpose mentioned above; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of the emergency appropriations created, including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is \$120,000 and three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the budget for 2014 is \$334,411.61; and

**WHEREAS**, the foregoing appropriation together with prior appropriations does not exceed three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations (including utility operation appropriations) in the budget for 2015.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by not less than 2/3 of all governing body members affirmatively concurring, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48:

1. An emergency appropriation is hereby made for  
Streets Salaries & Wages      \$ 20,000  
Streets Other Expenses      \$100,000  
Total      \$120,000
2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2016 budget, and is requested to be excluded from CAPS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53.3c(1).
3. That an Emergency Note not in excess of the above amount may be authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-51
4. That such note shall be executed by Robert Law, Chief Financial Officer and William J. Volk, Jr., Mayor.
5. That such note with a date to be determined, may be renewed from time to time, and such note and any renewals shall be payable on or before December 31, 2018.
6. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services


**Purpose of emergency appropriation:**
