RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SECURITY AND TECHNOLOGY ITEMS FROM RFP SOLUTIONS FOR THE NEW CITY OF WOODBURY POLICE STATION THROUGH CO-OPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury is in need of Security and Technology Items for the New Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury wishes to purchase such items through RFP Solutions pursuant to a contract with PEPPM, a nationally recognized co-operative purchasing agreement developed using a competitive bidding process for the amount of \$98,687.00; and

WHEREAS, purchases through such co-operatives are permitted by N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2; and

WHEREAS, the purchasing agent has determined that the use of the co-operative purchasing agreement shall result in cost savings considering all factors including charges for service, material and delivery; and

WHEREAS, the CFO has certified the availability of funds for such purchases.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Woodbury, the Mayor concurring, that the Mayor, Administrator and/or CFO are hereby authorized to execute such documents as necessary to effectuate the purchase of the afore-described Security and Technology Items reflected on the attachment to this resolution from RFP Solutions under PEPPM co-operative purchasing agreement for a purchase price of \$98,687.00.
