**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH
WINNER FORD FOR TWO (2) 2017 F350 UTILITY TRUCKS
THROUGH A STATE CONTRACT**

WHEREAS, it was determined that there existed the need for the purchase of two (2) 2017 F350 Utility Truck for use in the City of Woodbury Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that a purchase agreement with Winner Ford for the two (2) 2017 F350 Utility Trucks for the sum of \$69,218.00 was the agreement that best met the needs of the City with respect to the purchase of the trucks, while still meeting the City's budgetary concerns; and

WHEREAS, the purchase agreement for these public works vehicles are not subject to the mandatory bid requirements for municipalities in the State of New Jersey, as having been procured pursuant to State Contract A88758 T2101, including all requirements contained therein and under law; and


WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this purchase under the City budget line item.
