

RESOLUTION NO. 17-55

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF WENONAH FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE OFFICIAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbury has provided fire official services (fire code enforcement and inspections) for the Borough of Wenonah pursuant to a Shared Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement expired on December 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Wenonah and Woodbury to continue the Shared Services Agreement in the same manner and consistency as their prior relationship subject to the cost modification contained herein; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Woodbury to extend the Agreement with the Borough of Wenonah for the provision of fire official services from January 2, 2017, *nunc pro tunc*, through December 31, 2019, for the sum of \$ \$2,650 for the calendar year 2017, and a 2% increase in calendar years 2018 and 2019, respectively.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Woodbury, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, as follows:
