

ORDINANCE # 2254-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #2247-16 TO FIX AND ESTABLISH SALARIES AND RATE OF COMPENSATION ON THE VARIOUS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF WOODBURY IN THE COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, AND TO PROVIDE THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Woodbury, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The payment of all salaries and compensation required to be made under the provisions of this ordinance shall be on an annual, bi-weekly, quarterly or hourly pays-per-year basis commencing with the first pay period of January 2016, or as otherwise noted below.




